# New Trip Update



- To respect Clemson University's new international travel policy which restricts travel until August 2021, the trip has been rescheduled to December 12th - December 20th, 2021
  - *rare exception*: for students that are graduating this May and have already registered for May trip, they are still allowed to go with Texas A & M for their trip
- The new program is actually cheaper due to there being less days, the new total cost is \$1,660

# President Job Description

- Work with Vida Representative, Clemson Study Abroad Office, and students to help coordinate the trip
- Manage the club's accounts, for example, email and website
- Have informational meetings and re-register the club every year.
- Manage club bank account
- Has the ability to delegate responsibility to executive board



# Executive Board Description

- Has up to a maximum of four additional executive board members
- Assists the president with all of their responsibilities!
- For example, in the past, some previous executive members have helped with Tiger Prowl, creating social media advertisements, or helped answer questions from students about the trip
- The president can also choose, for example, to make one member of the board in charge of the bank account

# Benefits of Joining Vida Executive Board

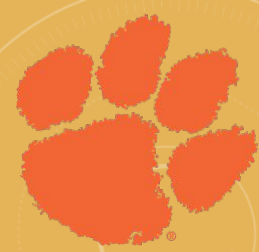
- The job is really a lot easier than it seems, while there is work to do, it's not very demanding or time-consuming. You can easily spend just 1 hour a week, and it'll reasonably get the job done.
- It looks really great on a resume to show that you have leadership experience, and it is very easy to talk about what you did in interviews
- The organization is already very structured, so you won't really need to "figure out" anything. All the responsibilities, resources, what to do, are already outlined for you, so you simply just need to follow it

- Lots of free promotional materials! Vida home office will often mail you free t-shirts for you and your club members, banners, flyers, etc. so there is even less work for you to fundraise money for stuff like shirts or banners.
